Matthew 10:11	"And whatever <3739 x-Strongs:G302> city <4172> or <2228> village <2968> you enter <1525>, inquire <1833> who <5101> is worthy <514> in it, and stay <3306> at his house <2546> until <2193> you leave <1831> that city.
Matthew 11:23	"And you, Capernaum <2746b>, will not be exalted <5312> to heaven <3772>, will you? You will descend <2597> to Hades <86>; for if <1487> the miracles <1411> had occurred <1096> in Sodom <4670> which occurred <1096> in you, it would have remained <3306> to this <4594> day <4594>.
Matthew 26:38	Then <5119> He said <3004> to them, "My soul <5590> is deeply <4036> grieved <4036>, to the point <2193> of death <2288>; remain <3306> here <5602> and keep <1127> watch <1127> with Me."
Mark 6:10	And He said <3004> to them, "Wherever <3699 x-Strongs:G1437> you enter <1525> a house <3614>, stay <3306> there <1563> until <2193> you leave <1831> town <1564>.
Mark 14:34	And He said <3004> to them, "My soul <5590> is deeply <4036> grieved <4036> to the point <2193> of death <2288>; remain <3306> here <5602> and keep <1127> watch <1127>."
Luke 1:56	And Mary <3137> stayed <3306> with her about <5613> three <5140> months <3376>, and then returned <5290> to her home <3624>.
Luke 8:27	And when He came <1831> out onto <1909> the land <1093>, He was met <5221> by a man <435> from the city <4172> who was possessed <2192> with demons <1140>; and who had not put <1746a> on any clothing <2440> for a long <2425> time <5550>, and was not living <3306> in a house <3614>, but in the tombs <3418>.
Luke 9:4	"Whatever <3739> house <3614> you enter <1525>, stay <3306> there <1563> until <2532> you leave <1831> that city <1563>.
Luke 10:7	"Stay <3306> in that house <3614>, eating <2068> and drinking <4095> what they give <3844> you; for the laborer <2040> is worthy <514> of his wages <3408>. Do not keep moving <3327> from house <3614> to house <3614>.
Luke 19:5	When <5613> Jesus <2424> came <2064> to the place <5117>, He looked <308> up and said <3004> to him, "Zaccheus <2195>, hurry <4692> and come <2597> down <2597>, for today <4594> I must <1163> stay <3306> at your house <3624>."
Luke 24:29	But they urged <3849> Him, saying <3004>, "Stay <3306> with us, for it is getting toward <4314> evening <2073>, and the day <2250> is now <2235> nearly <2827> over <2827>." So <2532> He went <1525> in to stay <3306> with them.

John 1:32	John <2491> testified <3140> saying <3004>, "I have seen <2300> the Spirit <4151> descending <2597> as a dove <4058> out of heaven <3772>, and He remained <3306> upon Him.
John 1:33	"I did not recognize <3609a> Him, but He who sent <3992> me to baptize <907> in water <5204> said <3004> to me, 'He upon whom <3739> you see <3708> the Spirit <4151> descending <2597> and remaining <3306> upon Him, this <3778> is the One who baptizes <907> in the Holy <40> Spirit <4151>.'
John 1:38	And Jesus <2424> turned <4762> and saw <2300> them following <190>, and said <3004> to them, "What <5101> do you seek <2212>?" They said <3004> to Him, "Rabbi <4461> (which <3739> translated <3177> means <3004> Teacher <1320>), where <4226> are You staying <3306>?"
John 1:39	He said <3004> to them, "Come <2064>, and you will see <3708>." So <3767> they came <2064> and saw <3708> where <4226> He was staying <3306>; and they stayed <3306> with Him that day <2250>, for it was about <5613> the tenth <1182> hour <5610>.
John 2:12	After <3326> this <3778> He went <2597> down <2597> to Capernaum <2746b>, He and His mother <3384> and His brothers <80> and His disciples <3101>; and they stayed <3306> there <1563> a few <3756 x-Strongs:G4183> days <2250>.
John 3:36	"He who believes <4100> in the Son <5207> has <2192> eternal <166> life <2222>; but he who does not obey <544> the Son <5207> will not see <3708> life <2222>, but the wrath <3709> of God <2316> abides <3306> on him."
John 4:40	So <3767> when <5613> the Samaritans <4541> came <2064> to Jesus, they were asking <2065> Him to stay <3306> with them; and He stayed <3306> there <1563> two <1417> days <2250>.
John 5:38	"You do not have <2192> His word <3056> abiding <3306> in you, for you do not believe <4100> Him whom <3739> He sent <649>.
John 6:27	"Do not work <2038b> for the food <1035> which perishes <622>, but for the food <1035> which endures <3306> to eternal <166> life <2222>, which <3739> the Son <5207> of Man <444> will give <1325> to you, for on Him the Father <3962>, God <2316>, has set <4972> His seal <4972>."
John 6:56	"He who eats <5176> My flesh <4561> and drinks <4095> My blood <129> abides <3306> in Me, and I in him.
John 7:9	Having said <3004> these <3778> things <3778> to them, He stayed <3306> in Galilee <1056>.
John 8:31	So <3767> Jesus <2424> was saying <3004> to those <3588> Jews <2453> who had believed <4100> Him, "If <1437> you continue <3306> in My word <3056>, then you are truly <230> disciples <3101> of Mine <1473>;
John 8:35	"The slave <1401> does not remain <3306> in the house <3614> forever <165>; the son <5207> does remain <3306> forever <165>.
John 9:41	Jesus <2424> said <3004> to them, "If <1487> you were blind <5185>, you would have <2192> no <3756> sin <266>; but since <3568> you say <3004>, 'We see <991>', your sin <266> remains <3306>.
John 10:40	And He went <565> away <565> again <3825> beyond <4008> the Jordan <2446> to the place <5117> where <3699> John <2491> was first <4413> baptizing <907>, and He was staying <3306> there <1563>.
John 11:6	So <3767> when <5613> He heard <191> that he was sick <770>, He then <5119> stayed <3306> two <1417> days <2250> longer in the place <5117> where <3739> He was.
John 11:54	Therefore <3767> Jesus <2424> no <3765> longer <3765> continued to walk <4043> publicly <3954> among <1722> the Jews <2453>, but went <565> away <565> from there <1564> to the country <5561> near <1451> the wilderness <2048>, into a city <4172> called <3004> Ephraim <2187>; and there <2546> He stayed <3306> with the disciples <3101>.
John 12:24	"Truly <281>, truly <281>, I say <3004> to you, unless <1437 x-Strongs:G3361> a grain <2848> of wheat <4621> falls <4098> into the earth <1093> and dies <599>, it remains <3306> alone <3441>; but if <1437> it dies <599>, it bears <5342> much <4183> fruit <2590>.
John 12:34	The crowd <3793> then <3767> answered <611> Him, "We have heard <191> out of the Law <3551> that the Christ <5547> is to remain <3306> forever <165>; and how <4459> can You say <3004>, 'The Son <5207> of Man <444> must <1163> be lifted <5312> up'? Who <5101> is this <3778> Son <5207> of Man <444>?"
John 12:46	"I have come <2064> as Light <5457> into the world <2889>, so <2443> that everyone <3956> who believes <4100> in Me will not remain <3306> in darkness <4653>.
John 14:10	"Do you not believe <4100> that I am in the Father <3962>, and the Father <3962> is in Me? The words <4487> that I say <3004> to you I do not speak <2980> on My own <1683> initiative <1683>, but the Father <3962> abiding <3306> in Me does <4160> His works <2041>.

John 14:17	that is the Spirit <4151> of truth <225>, whom <3739> the world <2889> cannot <1410 x-Strong's:G3756> receive <2983>, because <3754> it does not see <2334> Him or <3761> know <1097> Him, but you know <1097> Him because <3754> He abides <3306> with you and will be in you.
John 14:25	"These <3778> things <3778> I have spoken <2980> to you while abiding <3306> with you.
John 15:4	" Abide <3306> in Me, and I in you. As the branch <2814> cannot <1410><3756> bear <5342> fruit <2590> of itself <1438> unless <1437><3361> it abides <3306> in the vine <288>, so <3779> neither <3761> can you unless <1437><3361> you abide <3306> in Me.
John 15:5	"I am <1510> the vine <288>, you are the branches <2814>; he who abides <3306> in Me and I in him , he bears <5342> much <4183> fruit <2590>, for apart <5565> from Me you can <1410> do <4160> nothing <3756><3762>.
John 15:6	"If <1437> anyone <5100> does not abide <3306> in Me , he is thrown <906> away <1854> as a branch <2814> and dries <3583> up; and they gather <4863> them, and cast <906> them into the fire <4442> and they are burned <2545>.
John 15:7	"If <1437> you abide <3306> in Me, and My words <4487> abide <3306> in you , ask <154> whatever <3739 x-Strong's:G1437> you wish <2309>, and it will be done <1096> for you.
John 15:9	"Just <2531a> as the Father <3962> has loved <25> Me, I have also <2532> loved <25> you; abide <3306> in My love <26>.
John 15:10	" If <1437> you keep <5083> My commandments <1785>, you will abide <3306> in My love <26> ; just <2531a> as I have kept <5083> My Father's <3962> commandments <1785> and abide <3306> in His love <26>.
John 15:16	"You did not choose <1586> Me but I chose <1586> you, and appointed <5087> you that you would go <5217> and bear <5342> fruit <2590>, and that your fruit <2590> would remain <3306> , so <2443> that whatever <3739><302> you ask <154> of the Father <3962> in My name <3686> He may give <1325> to you.

John 19:31	Then <3767> the Jews <2453>, because <1893> it was the day <3904> of preparation <3904>, so <2443> that the bodies <4983> would not remain <3306> on the cross <4716> on the Sabbath <4521> (for that Sabbath <4521> was a high <3173> day <3904>), asked <2065> Pilate <4091> that their legs <4628> might be broken <2608a>, and that they might be taken <142> away <142>.
John 21:22	Jesus <2424> said <3004> to him, "If <1437> I want <2309> him to remain <3306> until <2193> I come <2064>, what <5101> is that to you? You follow <190> Me!"
John 21:23	Therefore <3767> this <3778> saying <3056> went <1831> out among <1519> the brethren <80> that that disciple <3101> would not die <599>; yet <1161> Jesus <2424> did not say <3004> to him that he would not die <599>, but only, "If <1437> I want <2309> him to remain <3306> until <2193> I come <2064>, what <5101> is that to you?"
Acts 5:4	"While it remained <3306> unsold, did it not remain <3306> your own? And after it was sold <4097>, was it not under <1722> your control <1849>? Why <5101> is it that you have conceived <5087> this <3778> deed <4229> in your heart <2588>? You have not lied <5574> to men <444> but to God <2316>."
Acts 9:43	And Peter stayed <3306> many <2425> days <2250> in Joppa <2445> with a tanner <1038> named Simon <4613>.
Acts 16:15	And when <5613> she and her household <3624> had been baptized <907>, she urged <3870> us, saying <3004>, "If <1487> you have judged <2919> me to be faithful <4103> to the Lord <2962>, come <1525> into my house <3624> and stay <3306>." And she prevailed <3849> upon us.
Acts 18:3	and because <1223> he was of the same <3673> trade <3673>, he stayed <3306> with them and they were working <2038b>, for by trade <5078> they were tent-makers <4635>.
Acts 18:20	When they asked <2065> him to stay <3306> for a longer <4183> time <5550>, he did not consent <1962>,
Acts 20:5	But these <3778> had gone <4281> on ahead <4281> and were waiting <3306> for us at Troas <5174>.
Acts 20:23	except <4133> that the Holy <40> Spirit <4151> solemnly <1263> testifies <1263> to me in every <2596> city <4172>, saying <3004> that bonds <1199> and afflictions <2347> await <3306> me.
Acts 21:7	When we had finished <1274> the voyage <4144> from Tyre <5184>, we arrived <2658> at Ptolemais <4424>, and after greeting <782> the brethren <80>, we stayed <3306> with them for a day <2250>.
Acts 21:8	On the next <1887> day <1887> we left <1831> and came <2064> to Caesarea <2542>, and entering <1525> the house <3624> of Philip <5376> the evangelist <2099>, who was one of the seven <2033>, we stayed <3306> with him.
Acts 27:31	Paul <3972> said <3004> to the centurion <1543> and to the soldiers <4757>, "Unless <1437 x-Strongs:G3361> these <3778> men <3778> remain <3306> in the ship <4143>, you yourselves <4771> cannot <1410 x-Strongs:G3756> be saved <4982>."
Acts 27:41	But striking <4045> a reef <5117> where <1337> two <1337> seas <1337> met <1337>, they ran <1946a> the vessel <3491> aground <1946a>; and the prow <4408> stuck <2043> fast <2043> and remained <3306> immovable <761>, but the stern <4403> began to be broken <3089> up by the force <970> of the waves.
Acts 28:16	When <3753> we entered <1525> Rome <4516>, Paul <3972> was allowed <2010> to stay <3306> by himself <1438>, with the soldier <4757> who was guarding <5442> him.
Romans 9:11	for though the twins were not yet <3380b> born <1080> and had not done <4238> anything <5100> good <18> or <2228> bad <5337>, so <2443> that God's <2316> purpose <4286> according <2596> to His choice <1589> would stand <3306>, not because <1537> of works <2041> but because <1537> of Him who calls <2564>,
I Corinthians 3:14	If <1487> any <5100> man's <5100> work <2041> which <3739> he has built <2026> on it remains <3306>, he will receive <2983> a reward <3408>.
I Corinthians 7:8	But I say <3004> to the unmarried <22> and to widows <5503> that it is good <2570> for them if <1437> they remain <3306> even <2532> as I.
I Corinthians 7:11	(but if <1437> she does leave <5563>, she must remain <3306> unmarried <22>, or <2228> else <2228> be reconciled <2644> to her husband <435>), and that the husband <435> should not divorce <863> his wife <1135>.
I Corinthians 7:20	Each <1538> man <1538> must remain <3306> in that condition <2821> in which <3739> he was called <2564>.
I Corinthians 7:24	Brethren <80>, each <1538> one <1538> is to remain <3306> with God <2316> in that condition in which <3739> he was called <2564>.
I Corinthians 7:40	But in my opinion <1106> she is happier <3107> if <1437> she remains <3306> as she is; and I think <1380> that I also <2532> have <2192> the Spirit <4151> of God <2316>.
I Corinthians 13:13	But now <3570> faith <4102>, hope <1680>, love <26>, abide <3306> these <3778> three <5140>; but the greatest <3173> of these <3778> is love <26>.
I Corinthians 15:6	After <1899> that He appeared <3708> to more <1883> than <1883> five <4001> hundred <4001> brethren <80> at one <2178> time <2178>, most <4183> of whom <3739> remain <3306> until <2193> now <737>, but some <5100> have fallen <2837> asleep <2837>;

II Corinthians 3:11	For if <1487> that which fades <2673> away <2673> was with glory <1391>, much <4183> more <3123> that which remains <3306> is in glory <1391>.
II Corinthians 3:14	But their minds <3540> were hardened <4456>; for until <891> this <4594> very <4594> day <2250> at the reading <320> of the old <3820> covenant <1242> the same <846> veil <2571> remains <3306> unlifted <343>, because <3754> it is removed <2673> in Christ <5547>.
II Corinthians 9:9	as it is written <1125>, "He scattered <4650> abroad, he gave <1325> to the poor <3993>, His righteousness <1343> endures <3306> forever <165>."
Philippians 1:25	Convinced <3982> of this <3778>, I know <3609a> that I will remain <3306> and continue <3887> with you all <3956> for your progress <4297> and joy <5479> in the faith <4102>,
I Timothy 2:15	But women will be preserved <4982> through <1223> the bearing <5042> of children <5042> if <1437> they continue <3306> in faith <4102> and love <26> and sanctity <38> with self-restraint <4997>.
II Timothy 2:13	If <1487> we are faithless <569>, He remains <3306> faithful <4103>, for He cannot <1410 x-Strongs:G3756> deny <720> Himself <1438>.
II Timothy 3:14	You, however <1161>, continue <3306> in the things <3739> you have learned <3129> and become convinced <4104> of, knowing <3609a> from whom <5101> you have learned <3129> them,
II Timothy 4:20	Erastus <2037> remained <3306> at Corinth <2882>, but Trophimus <5161> I left <620> sick <770> at Miletus <3399>.
Hebrews 7:3	Without <540> father <540>, without <282> mother <282>, without <35> genealogy <35>, having <2192> neither <3383> beginning <746> of days <2250> nor <3383> end <5056> of life <2222>, but made <871> like <871> the Son <5207> of God <2316>, he remains <3306> a priest <2409> perpetually <1519 x-Strongs:G1336>.
Hebrews 7:24	but Jesus, on the other <1161> hand <1161>, because <1223> He continues <3306> forever <165>, holds <2192> His priesthood <2420> permanently <531>.
Hebrews 10:34	For you showed <4834> sympathy <4834> to the prisoners <1198> and accepted <4327> joyfully <5479> the seizure <724> of your property <5225>, knowing <1097> that you have <2192> for yourselves <1438> a better <2909> possession <5223> and a lasting <3306> one.
Hebrews 12:27	This <3588> expression, "Yet <2089> once <530> more <530>," denotes <1213> the removing <3331> of those <3588> things which can be shaken <4531>, as of created <4160> things <4160>, so <2443> that those <3588> things which cannot <3361> be shaken <4531> may remain <3306>.
Hebrews 13:1	Let love <5360> of the brethren <5360> continue <3306>.
Hebrews 13:14	For here <5602> we do not have <2192> a lasting <3306> city <4172>, but we are seeking <1934> the city which is to come <3195>.
I Peter 1:23	for you have been born <313> again <313> not of seed <4701> which <5349> is perishable <5349> but imperishable <862a>, that is, through <1223> the living <2198> and enduring <3306> word <3056> of God <2316>.
I Peter 1:25	But the word <4487> of the Lord <2962> endures <3306> forever <165>." His righteousness <1343> endures <3306> forever <165>." And this <3778> is the word <4487> which was preached <2097> to you.
I John 2:6	the one who says <3004> he abides <3306> in Him ought <3784> himself <846> to walk <4043> in the same <3779> manner <3779> as He walked <4043>.
I John 2:10	The one who loves <25> his brother <80> abides <3306> in the Light <5457> and there is no <3756> cause <4625> for stumbling <4625> in him.
I John 2:14	I have written <1125> to you, fathers <3962>, because <3754> you know <1097> Him who has been from the beginning <746>. I have written <1125> to you, young <3495> men <3495>, because <3754> you are strong <2478>, and the word <3056> of God <2316> abides <3306> in you, and you have overcome <3528> the evil <4190> one <4190>.
I John 2:17	The world <2889> is passing <3855> away <3855>, and also its lusts <1939>; but the one who does <4160> the will <2307> of God <2316> lives <3306> forever <165>.
I John 2:19	They went <1831> out from us, but they were not really of us; for if <1487> they had been <1510> of us, they would have remained <3306> with us; but they went out, so <2443> that it would be shown <5319> that they all <3956> are not of us.
I John 2:24	As for you, let that abide <3306> in you which <3739> you heard <191> from the beginning <746>. If <1437> what <3739> you heard <191> from the beginning <746> abides <3306> in you, you also <2532> will abide <3306> in the Son <5207> and in the Father <3962>.
I John 2:27	As for you, the anointing <5545> which <3739> you received <2983> from Him abides <3306> in you, and you have <2192> no <3756> need <5532> for anyone <5100> to teach <1321> you; but as His anointing <5545> teaches <1321> you about <4012> all <3956> things <3956>, and is true <227> and is not a lie <5579>, and just <2531a> as it has taught <1321> you, you abide <3306> in Him.
I John 2:28	Now <3568>, little <5040> children <5040>, abide <3306> in Him, so <2443> that when <1437> He appears <5319>, we may have <2192> confidence <3954> and not shrink <153> away <575> from Him in shame <153> at His coming <3952>.

I John 3:6	No <3956 x-Strongs:G3756> one <3956> who abides <3306> in Him sins <264>; no <3956 x-Strongs:G3756> one <3956> who sins <264> has seen <3708> Him or <3761> knows <1097> Him.
I John 3:9	No <3956 x-Strongs:G3756> one <3956> who is born <1080> of God <2316> practices <4160> sin <266>, because <3754> His seed <4690> abides <3306> in him; and he cannot <1410 x-Strongs:G3756> sin <264>, because <3754> he is born <1080> of God <2316>.
I John 3:14	We know <3609a> that we have passed <3327> out of death <2288> into life <2222>, because <3754> we love <25> the brethren <80>. He who does not love <25> abides <3306> in death <2288>.
I John 3:15	Everyone <3956> who hates <3404> his brother <80> is a murderer <443>; and you know <3609a> that no <3956 x-Strongs:G3756> murderer <443> has <2192> eternal <166> life <2222> abiding <3306> in him.
I John 3:17	But whoever <3739 x-Strongs:G302> has <2192> the world's <2889> goods <979>, and sees <2334> his brother <80> in need <5532> and closes <2808> his heart <4698> against <575> him, how <4459> does the love <26> of God <2316> abide <3306> in him?
I John 3:24	The one who keeps <5083> His commandments <1785> abides <3306> in Him, and He in him. We know <1097> by this <3778> that He abides <3306> in us, by the Spirit <4151> whom <3739> He has given <1325> us.
I John 4:12	No <3762> one <3762> has seen <2300> God <2316> at any <4455> time <4455>; if <1437> we love <25> one <240> another <240>, God <2316> abides <3306> in us, and His love <26> is perfected <5048> in us.
I John 4:13	By this <3778> we know <1097> that we abide <3306> in Him and He in us, because <3754> He has given <1325> us of His Spirit <4151>.
I John 4:15	Whoever <3739 x-Strongs:G1437> confesses <3670> that Jesus <2424> is the Son <5207> of God <2316>, God <2316> abides <3306> in him, and he in God <2316>.
I John 4:16	We have come <1097> to know <1097> and have believed <4100> the love <26> which <3739> God <2316> has <2192> for us. God <2316> is love <26>, and the one who abides <3306> in love <26> abides <3306> in God <2316>, and God <2316> abides <3306> in him.
II John 1:2	for the sake <1223> of the truth <225> which abides <3306> in us and will be with us forever <165>:
II John 1:9	Anyone <3956> who goes <4254> too <4254> far <4254> and does not abide <3306> in the teaching <1322> of Christ <5547>, does not have <2192> God <2316>; the one who abides <3306> in the teaching <1322>, he has <2192> both <2532> the Father <3962> and the Son <5207>.
Revelation of John 17:10	and they are seven <2033> kings <935>; five <4002> have fallen <4098>, one <1520> is, the other <243> has not yet <3768> come <2064>; and when <3752> he comes <2064>, he must <1163> remain <3306> a little <3641> while <3641>.
