

Psalms 1:6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.  
 The Lord honers the righteous.

Psalms 2:11 Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.  
 The Lord is to be revered and feared.

Psalms 3:3 But thou, O LORD, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.  
 The Lord protects me, my reputation, and my spirit.

Psalms 3:4 I cried unto the LORD with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah.  
 The Lord hears me.

Psalms 3:5 I laid me down and slept; I awaked; for the LORD sustained me.  
 The Lord sustains me.

Psalms 3:7 Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies upon the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly  
 The Lord smites the enemies of the Godly.

Psalms 3:8 Salvation belongeth unto the LORD: thy blessing is upon thy people. Selah.  
 The Lord alone saves. He blesses His people.

Psalms 4:1 Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me when I was in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.  
 The Lord provides my righteousness and saves me in my distress.

Psalms 4:3 But know that the LORD hath set apart him that is godly for himself: the LORD will hear when I call unto him.  
 The Lord honers the righteous.

Psalms 4:8 I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety.  
 The Lord keeps me safe.

Psalms 5:4 For thou art not a God that hath pleasure in wickedness: neither shall evil dwell with thee.  
 The Lord does not honor the wicked.

Psalms 5:6 Thou shalt destroy them that speak leasing: the LORD will abhor the bloody and deceitful man.  
 The Lord destroys the wicked.

Psalms 5:12 For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.  
 The Lord honours the righteous.

Psalms 6:1 O LORD, rebuke me not in thine anger, neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure.

Psalms 6:2 Have mercy upon me, O LORD; for I am weak: O LORD, heal me; for my bones are vexed.

Psalms 6:3 My soul is also sore vexed: but thou, O LORD, how long?

Psalms 6:4 Return, O LORD, deliver my soul: oh save me for thy mercies'sake.  
 The Lord allows the righteous to sin and lets the consequences of sin to manifest, to a degree.

Psalms 6:8 Depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity; for the LORD hath heard the voice of my weeping.

Psalms 6:9 The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer.  
 The Lord hears the repenting voice of the prodigal.

Psalms 7:8 The LORD shall judge the people: judge me, O LORD, according to my righteousness, and according to mine integrity that is in me.  
 The Lord will judge the people. This verse is scary. I shouldn't dare ask the Lord to judge me according to MY righteousness and

Psalms 7:9 Oh let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end; but establish the just: for the righteous God trieth the hearts and reins.  
 The Lord tests and knows the hearts and reins.

Psalms 7:10 My defence is of God, which saveth the upright in heart.  
 The Lord saves the upright in heart.

Psalms 7:11 God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry with the wicked every day.  
 The Lord judges the righteous and is angry with the wicked every day.

Psalms 7:17 I will praise the LORD according to his righteousness: and will sing praise to the name of the LORD most high.  
 The Lord is righteous and most high!

Psalms 8:1 O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens.

Psalms 8:9 O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth!  
 The Lord's Name is excellent and His Glory is above the heavens!

Psalms 9:1 I will praise thee, O LORD, with my whole heart; I will shew forth all thy marvellous works.  
 The Lord's works are marvellous.

Psalms 9:7 But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment.  
 The Lord is everlasting and will judge.

Psalms 9:9 The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble.  
 The Lord will be a refuge in times of trouble for the oppressed.

Psalms 9:10 And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.  
 The Lord does not forsake them that seek Him.

Psalms 9:13 Have mercy upon me, O LORD; consider my trouble which I suffer of them that hate me, thou that liftest me up from the gates of death:  
 The Lord lifts me up from the gates of death.

Psalms 9:16 The LORD is known by the judgment which he executeth: the wicked is snared in the work of his own hands. Higgaion. Selah.  
 The Lord judges the wicked even in this life.

Psalms 9:17 The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God.  
 The Lord judges the wicked for the next life.

Psalms 10:1 Why standest thou afar off, O LORD? why hidest thou thyself in times of trouble?  
 Sometimes the Lord lets the righteous go through times of trouble.

Psalms 10:3 For the wicked boasteth of his heart' desire, and blesseth the covetous, whom the LORD abhorreth.  
 The Lord abhors the covetous.

Psalms 10:16 The LORD is King for ever and ever: the heathen are perished out of his land.  
 The Lord is King forever and ever!!

Psalms 10:17 LORD, thou hast heard the desire of the humble: thou wilt prepare their heart, thou wilt cause thine ear to hear:  
 The Lord hears the desires of the humble. He prepares their heart.

Psalms 11:4 The LORD is in his holy temple, the LORD' throne is in heaven: his eyes behold, his eyelids try, the children of men.  
 The Lord observes and judges all men.

Psalms 11:5 The LORD trieth the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth violence his soul hateth.  
 The Lord honours the righteous and hates the wicked.

Psalms 11:7 For the righteous LORD loveth righteousness; his countenance doth behold the upright.  
 The Lord honours the righteous.

Psalms 12:1 Help, LORD; for the godly man ceaseth; for the faithful fail from among the children of men.  
 The Lord sometimes lets us misunderstand his sovereignty.

Psalms 12:3 The LORD shall cut off all flattering lips, and the tongue that speaketh proud things:  
 The Lord cuts off the wicked and the proud.

Psalms 12:5 For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, now will I arise, saith the LORD; I will set him in safety from him that puffeth at I

Psalms 12:7 Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.  
 The Lord saves the poor and needed from the wicked.

Psalms 12:6 The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.  
 The Lord speaks pure truth.

Psalms 13:1 How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?  
 Sometimes the Lord lets the righteous go through times of trouble.

Psalms 13:6 I will sing unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me.  
 The Lord saves.

Psalms 14:2 The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.  
 The Lord observes and judges all men.

Psalms 14:5 There were they in great fear: for God is in the generation of the righteous.  
 The Lord upholds the righteous.

Psalms 14:6 Ye have shamed the counsel of the poor, because the LORD is his refuge.  
 The Lord is the refuge of the righteous.

Psalms 15:1 LORD, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? who shall dwell in thy holy hill?  
 Psalms 15:2 He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart.  
 The Lord fellowships with the righteous.

Psalms 16:5 The LORD is the portion of mine inheritance and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot.  
 The Lord IS my inheritance.

Psalms 16:7 I will bless the LORD, who hath given me counsel: my reins also instruct me in the night seasons.  
 The Lord gives me counsel and guidance.

Psalms 16:8 I have set the LORD always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.  
 The Lord is at my right hand and I shall not be moved.

Psalms 17:6 I have called upon thee, for thou wilt hear me, O God: incline thine ear unto me, and hear my speech.  
 The Lord hears me.

Psalms 18:1 I will love thee, O LORD, my strength.  
 Psalms 18:2 The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation  
 The Lord is my strength, rock, fortress, deliverer, buckler, horn of my salvation, and high tower!!!

Psalms 18:3 I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.  
 The Lord will save me from my enemies.

Psalms 18:6 In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, even into  
 The Lord hears me.

Psalms 18:13 The LORD also thundered in the heavens, and the Highest gave his voice; hail stones and coals of fire.  
 Psalms 18:15 Then the channels of waters were seen, and the foundations of the world were discovered at thy rebuke, O LORD, at the blast of the breath  
 The Lord is mighty!

Psalms 18:18 They prevented me in the day of my calamity: but the LORD was my stay.  
 The Lord upholds me.

Psalms 18:20 The LORD rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands hath he recompensed me.  
 Psalms 18:21 For I have kept the ways of the LORD, and have not wickedly departed from my God.  
 Psalms 18:24 Therefore hath the LORD recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands in his eyesight.  
 The Lord honers the righteous.

Psalms 18:28 For thou wilt light my candle: the LORD my God will enlighten my darkness.  
 The Lord is my guidance.

Psalms 18:29 For by thee I have run through a troop; and by my God have I leaped over a wall.  
 The Lord is my strength.

Psalms 18:30 As for God, his way is perfect: the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.  
 The Lord is perfect and protects those who trust in Him.

Psalms 18:31 For who is God save the LORD? or who is a rock save our God?  
 The Lord ALONE is God and our Rock!

Psalms 18:32 It is God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect.  
 The Lord ALONE is my strength and guidance.

Psalms 18:41 They cried, but there was none to save them: even unto the LORD, but he answered them not.  
 The Lord does not answer the cry to Him from the enemy of the righteous.

Psalms 18:47 It is God that avengeth me, and subdueth the people under me.  
 The Lord avenges.

Psalms 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.  
 The Lord is praised by His creation.

Psalms 19:7 The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.  
 Psalms 19:8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes.  
 Psalms 19:9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.  
 The Lord is true and teaches.

Psalms 19:14 Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.  
 The Lord is my strength and redeemer.

Psalms 20:6 Now know I that the LORD saveth his anointed; he will hear him from his holy heaven with the saving strength of his right hand.  
 The Lord hears and saves his anointed.

Psalms 21:7 For the king trusteth in the LORD, and through the mercy of the most High he shall not be moved.  
 God upholds in His Mercy!

Psalms 21:9 Thou shalt make them as a fiery oven in the time of thine anger: the LORD shall swallow them up in his wrath, and the fire shall devour them  
 The Lord devours His enemy.

Psalms 21:13 Be thou exalted, LORD, in thine own strength: so will we sing and praise thy power.  
 The Lord is strong.

Psalms 22:1 My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?  
 Psalms 22:2 O my God, I cry in the daytime, but thou hearest not; and in the night season, and am not silent.  
 Sometimes the Lord lets the righteous go through times of trouble.

Psalms 22:8 He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.  
 Sometimes the Lord lets the righteous go through times of trouble.

Psalms 22:10 I was cast upon thee from the womb: thou art my God from my mother' belly.  
 The Lord keeps us from our birth.

Psalms 22:19 But be not thou far from me, O LORD: O my strength, haste thee to help me.  
 The Lord is my strength and my help.

Psalms 22:26 The meek shall eat and be satisfied: they shall praise the LORD that seek him: your heart shall live for ever.  
 The Lord provides for the meek and saves forever!

Psalms 22:27 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the LORD: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before thee.  
 The Lord shall be worshipped by all His creation!

Psalms 22:28 For the kingdom is the LORD': and he is the governor among the nations.  
 The Lord is over all kingdoms and nations.

Psalms 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want..  
 The Lord takes care of my needs.

Psalms 23:6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.  
     The Lord saves forever!  
 Psalms 24:1 The earth is the LORD's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.  
     The Lord is creator and over all creation.  
 Psalms 24:3 Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place?  
     The Lord is Holy!  
 Psalms 24:5 He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation.  
     The Lord blesses those who fear Him and walk in His ways!  
 Psalms 24:8 Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle.  
     The Lord is strong and mighty in battle!  
 Psalms 24:10 Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory. Selah.  
     The Lord reigns over all and is most Glorious!  
 Psalms 25:4 Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.  
 Psalms 25:5 Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.  
     The Lord's ways and paths are truth! The Lord solely provides my salvation!  
 Psalms 25:6 Remember, O LORD, thy tender mercies and thy lovingkindnesses; for they have been ever of old.  
 Psalms 25:7 Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness's sake, O LORD.  
     The Lord is, from old, tender merciful and lovingkind.  
 Psalms 25:8 Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way.  
 Psalms 25:10 All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies.  
 Psalms 25:12 What man is he that feareth the LORD? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose.  
 Psalms 25:14 The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.  
     The Lord is good, upright, merciful, and teaches sinners in the way-- those who keep His covenant and testimonies.  
 Psalms 25:15 Mine eyes are ever toward the LORD; for he shall pluck my feet out of the net.  
     The Lord will rescue me from trouble.  
 Psalms 26:8 LORD, I have loved the habitation of thy house, and the place where thine honour dwelleth.  
     The Lord is honorable!  
 Psalms 26:12 My foot standeth in an even place: in the congregations will I bless the LORD.  
     The Lord provides and even place for my foot!  
 Psalms 27:1 The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?  
     The Lord is my light, salvation, and strength of my life!  
 Psalms 27:4 One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and I will be satisfied.  
     The Lord is beautiful!  
 Psalms 27:5 For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.  
 Psalms 27:6 And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, because the LORD hath heard my voice.  
     The Lord protects me in times of trouble and establishes me and raises my head above my enemies.  
 Psalms 27:8 When thou saidst, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy face, LORD, will I seek.  
     The Lord calls us to seek His Face!  
 Psalms 27:9 Hide not thy face far from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.  
     The Lord is my help and salvation!  
 Psalms 27:10 When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.  
     The Lord upholds me when those closest to me forsake me!  
 Psalms 27:11 Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.  
     The Lord's way is plain!  
 Psalms 27:13 I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.  
     The Lord is good!  
 Psalms 27:14 Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.  
     The Lord strengthens the heart of those who wait on Him!  
 Psalms 28:1 Unto thee will I cry, O LORD my rock; be not silent to me: lest, if thou be silent to me, I become like them that go down into the pit.  
     The Lord is my Rock! He is The One Who sustains me!  
 Psalms 28:5 Because they regard not the works of the LORD, nor the operation of his hands, he shall destroy them, and not build them up.  
     The Lord destroys those who do not regard His works.  
 Psalms 28:6 Blessed be the LORD, because he hath heard the voice of my supplications.  
     The Lord hears my supplications!  
 Psalms 28:7 The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise thee, O LORD.  
 Psalms 28:8 The LORD is their strength, and he is the saving strength of his anointed.  
     The Lord is my strength, my shield, and my help!  
 Psalms 29:1 Give unto the LORD, O ye mighty, give unto the LORD glory and strength.  
 Psalms 29:2 Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.  
     The Lord is due glory and strength from men in the beauty of holiness.  
 Psalms 29:3 The voice of the LORD is upon the waters: the God of glory thundereth: the LORD is upon many waters.  
 Psalms 29:4 The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.  
 Psalms 29:5 The voice of the LORD breaketh the cedars; yea, the LORD breaketh the cedars of Lebanon.  
 Psalms 29:7 The voice of the LORD divideth the flames of fire.  
 Psalms 29:8 The voice of the LORD shaketh the wilderness; the LORD shaketh the wilderness of Kadesh.  
 Psalms 29:9 The voice of the LORD maketh the hinds to calve, and discovereth the forests: and in his temple doth every one speak of his glory.  
 Psalms 29:10 The LORD sitteth upon the flood; yea, the LORD sitteth King for ever.  
     The Lord is over all his creation!  
 Psalms 29:11 The LORD will give strength unto his people; the LORD will bless his people with peace.  
     The Lord blesses with strength and peace to His people.  
 Psalms 30:1 I will extol thee, O LORD; for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.  
 Psalms 30:2 O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.  
 Psalms 30:3 O LORD, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.  
     The Lord lifts me up from the grave, protects me from my foes, heals me, and keeps me alive!  
 Psalms 30:4 Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness.  
     The Lord is Holy!  
 Psalms 30:7 LORD, by thy favour thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: thou didst hide thy face, and I was troubled.  
     The Lord makes my mountain stand strong, but sometimes hides His Face from me.  
 Psalms 31:1 In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in thy righteousness.  
     The Lord is righteous!  
 Psalms 31:5 Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth.  
     The Lord redeems me and is of truth!  
 Psalms 31:9 Have mercy upon me, O LORD, for I am in trouble: mine eye is consumed with grief, yea, my soul and my belly.  
 Psalms 31:14 But I trusted in thee, O LORD: I said, Thou art my God.

Psalms 31:17 Let me not be ashamed, O LORD; for I have called upon thee: let the wicked be ashamed, and let them be silent in the grave.  
 Psalms 31:21 Blessed be the LORD: for he hath shewed me his marvellous kindness in a strong city.  
 Psalms 31:23 O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.  
 Psalms 31:24 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.  
     The Lord let's us undergo grief for a time so we will cry out to Him and UNDERSTAND His salvation!  
 Psalms 32:2 Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.  
 Psalms 32:5 I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest  
 Psalms 32:10 Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about.  
 Psalms 32:11 Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy, all ye that are upright in heart.  
 Psalms 33:1 Rejoice in the LORD, O ye righteous: for praise is comely for the upright.  
 Psalms 33:2 Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery and an instrument of ten strings.  
 Psalms 33:4 For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth.  
 Psalms 33:5 He loveth righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.  
 Psalms 33:6 By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.  
 Psalms 33:8 Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.  
 Psalms 33:10 The LORD bringeth the counsel of the heathen to nought: he maketh the devices of the people of none effect.  
 Psalms 33:11 The counsel of the LORD standeth for ever, the thoughts of his heart to all generations.  
 Psalms 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD; and the people whom he hath chosen for his own inheritance.  
 Psalms 33:13 The LORD looketh from heaven; he beholdeth all the sons of men.  
 Psalms 33:18 Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy;  
 Psalms 33:20 Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield.  
 Psalms 33:22 Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we hope in thee.  
 Psalms 34:1 I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth.  
 Psalms 34:2 My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad.  
 Psalms 34:3 O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together.  
 Psalms 34:4 I sought the LORD, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.  
 Psalms 34:6 This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles.  
 Psalms 34:7 The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.  
 Psalms 34:8 O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him.  
 Psalms 34:9 O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for there is no want to them that fear him.  
 Psalms 34:10 The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.  
 Psalms 34:11 Come, ye children, hearken unto me: I will teach you the fear of the LORD.  
 Psalms 34:15 The eyes of the LORD are upon the righteous, and his ears are open unto their cry.  
 Psalms 34:16 The face of the LORD is against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.  
 Psalms 34:17 The righteous cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.  
 Psalms 34:18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.  
 Psalms 34:19 Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.  
 Psalms 34:22 The LORD redeemeth the soul of his servants: and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate.  
 Psalms 35:1 Plead my cause, O LORD, with them that strive with me: fight against them that fight against me.  
 Psalms 35:5 Let them be as chaff before the wind: and let the angel of the LORD chase them.  
 Psalms 35:6 Let their way be dark and slippery: and let the angel of the LORD persecute them.  
 Psalms 35:9 And my soul shall be joyful in the LORD: it shall rejoice in his salvation.

 Psalms 35:22 This thou hast seen, O LORD: keep not silence: O Lord, be not far from me.  
 Psalms 35:23 Stir up thyself, and awake to my judgment, even unto my cause, my God and my Lord.  
 Psalms 35:24 Judge me, O LORD my God, according to thy righteousness; and let them not rejoice over me.  
 Psalms 35:27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pl  
 Psalms 36:1 The transgression of the wicked saith within my heart, that there is no fear of God before his eyes.  
 Psalms 36:5 Thy mercy, O LORD, is in the heavens; and thy faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds.  
 Psalms 36:6 Thy righteousness is like the great mountains; thy judgments are a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast.  
 Psalms 36:7 How excellent is thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings.  
 Psalms 37:3 Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.

 Psalms 37:23 The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way.  
 Psalms 37:24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholdeth him with his hand.  
 Psalms 37:28 For the LORD loveth judgment, and forsaketh not his saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.  
 Psalms 37:31 The law of his God is in his heart; none of his steps shall slide.  
 Psalms 37:33 The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged.  
 Psalms 37:34 Wait on the LORD, and keep his way, and he shall exalt thee to inherit the land: when the wicked are cut off, thou shalt see it.

 Psalms 40:1 I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry.  
     The Lord hears those who wait upon Him.  
 Psalms 40:3 And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.  
     The Lord reminds us of His attributes so we might praise His name!  
 Psalms 40:4 Blessed is that man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.  
     The Lord blesses those who trust in Him and have a like heart.  
 Psalms 40:5 Many, O LORD my God, are thy wonderful works which thou hast done, and thy thoughts which are to us-ward: they cannot be reckoned up  
 Psalms 40:8 I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law is within my heart.  
 Psalms 40:9 I have preached righteousness in the great congregation: lo, I have not refrained my lips, O LORD, thou knowest.  
 Psalms 40:11 Withhold not thou thy tender mercies from me, O LORD: let thy lovingkindness and thy truth continually preserve me.  
 Psalms 40:13 Be pleased, O LORD, to deliver me: O LORD, make haste to help me.  
 Psalms 40:16 Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee: let such as love thy salvation say continually, The LORD be magnified.

Psalms 40:17 But I am poor and needy; yet the Lord thinketh upon me: thou art my help and my deliverer; make no tarrying, O my God.

 Psalms 43:1 Judge me, O God, and plead my cause against an ungodly nation: O deliver me from the deceitful and unjust man.

 Psalms 43:4 Then will I go unto the altar of God, unto God my exceeding joy: yea, upon the harp will I praise thee, O God my God.

 Psalms 45:6 Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre.

 Psalms 45:7 Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness: therefore God, thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.  
 Psalms 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.  
 The Lord is our refuge, strength, and help!  
 Psalms 46:4 There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High.  
 Psalms 46:5 God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved: God shall help her, and that right early.  
 Psalms 46:7 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah.  
 Psalms 46:8 Come, behold the works of the LORD, what desolations he hath made in the earth.  
 Psalms 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.  
 Psalms 46:11 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah.  
 Psalms 47:1 O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph.  
 Psalms 47:2 For the LORD most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth.

 Psalms 47:8 God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness.  
 Psalms 47:9 The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is  
 Psalms 48:1 Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in the mountain of his holiness.  
 Psalms 48:3 God is known in her palaces for a refuge.  
 Psalms 48:8 As we have heard, so have we seen in the city of the LORD of hosts, in the city of our God: God will establish it for ever. Selah.  
 Psalms 48:9 We have thought of thy lovingkindness, O God, in the midst of thy temple.  
 Psalms 48:10 According to thy name, O God, so is thy praise unto the ends of the earth: thy right hand is full of righteousness.  
 Psalms 48:14 For this God is our God for ever and ever: he will be our guide even unto death.  
 Psalms 49:7 None of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him:  
 Psalms 49:15 But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for he shall receive me. Selah.

 Psalms 50:2 Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God hath shined.

 Psalms 50:6 And the heavens shall declare his righteousness: for God is judge himself. Selah.

 Psalms 50:14 Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most High:  
 Psalms 50:16 But unto the wicked God saith, What hast thou to do to declare my statutes, or that thou shouldest take my covenant in thy mouth?  
 Psalms 50:22 Now consider this, ye that forget God, lest I tear you in pieces, and there be none to deliver.  
 Psalms 50:23 Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I shew the salvation of God.  
 Psalms 51:1 Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgre  
 Psalms 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.  
 Psalms 51:14 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my salvation: and my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness.  
 Psalms 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.  
 Psalms 52:1 Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God endureth continually.  
 Psalms 52:5 God shall likewise destroy thee for ever, he shall take thee away, and pluck thee out of thy dwelling place, and root thee out of the land of th  
 Psalms 52:7 Lo, this is the man that made not God his strength; but trusted in the abundance of his riches, and strengthened himself in his wickedness.  
 Psalms 52:8 But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God: I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever.

 Psalms 54:4 Behold, God is mine helper: the Lord is with them that uphold my soul.

 Psalms 56:9 When I cry unto thee, then shall mine enemies turn back: this I know; for God is for me.

 Psalms 57:5 Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens; let thy glory be above all the earth.  
 Psalms 57:7 My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed: I will sing and give praise.  
 Psalms 57:11 Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: let thy glory be above all the earth.  
 Psalms 58:6 Break their teeth, O God, in their mouth: break out the great teeth of the young lions, O LORD.

 Psalms 59:8 But thou, O LORD, shalt laugh at them; thou shalt have all the heathen in derision.  
 Psalms 59:9 Because of his strength will I wait upon thee: for God is my defence.  
 Psalms 59:10 The God of my mercy shall prevent me: God shall let me see my desire upon mine enemies.  
 Psalms 59:13 Consume them in wrath, consume them, that they may not be: and let them know that God ruleth in Jacob unto the ends of the earth. Selah  
 Psalms 59:17 Unto thee, O my strength, will I sing: for God is my defence, and the God of my mercy.  
 Psalms 60:1 O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.  
 Psalms 60:6 God hath spoken in his holiness; I will rejoice, I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth.  
 Psalms 60:10 Wilt not thou, O God, which hadst cast us off? and thou, O God, which didst not go out with our armies?

 Psalms 68:7 O God, when thou wentest forth before thy people, when thou didst march through the wilderness; Selah:  
 Psalms 68:8 The earth shook, the heavens also dropped at the presence of God: even Sinai itself was moved at the presence of God, the God of Israel.  
 Psalms 68:9 Thou, O God, didst send a plentiful rain, whereby thou didst confirm thine inheritance, when it was weary.  
 Psalms 68:10 Thy congregation hath dwelt therein: thou, O God, hast prepared of thy goodness for the poor.  
 Psalms 68:15 The hill of God is as the hill of Bashan; an high hill as the hill of Bashan.  
 Psalms 68:16 Why leap ye, ye high hills? this is the hill which God desireth to dwell in; yea, the LORD will dwell in it for ever.  
 Psalms 68:17 The chariots of God are twenty thousand, even thousands of angels: the Lord is among them, as in Sinai, in the holy place.

 Psalms 68:28 Thy God hath commanded thy strength: strengthen, O God, that which thou hast wrought for us.  
 Psalms 68:31 Princes shall come out of Egypt; Ethiopia shall soon stretch out her hands unto God.  
 Psalms 68:32 Sing unto God, ye kingdoms of the earth; O sing praises unto the Lord; Selah:  
 Psalms 68:34 Ascribe ye strength unto God: his excellency is over Israel, and his strength is in the clouds.  
 Psalms 68:35 O God, thou art terrible out of thy holy places: the God of Israel is he that giveth strength and power unto his people. Blessed be God.  
 Psalms 69:1 Save me, O God; for the waters are come in unto my soul.  
 Psalms 69:3 I am weary of my crying: my throat is dried: mine eyes fail while I wait for my God.

 Psalms 71:17 O God, thou hast taught me from my youth: and hitherto have I declared thy wondrous works.  
 Psalms 71:18 Now also when I am old and grayheaded, O God, forsake me not; until I have shewed thy strength unto this generation, and thy power to ev  
 Psalms 71:19 Thy righteousness also, O God, is very high, who hast done great things: O God, who is like unto thee!  
 Psalms 71:22 I will also praise thee with the psaltery, even thy truth, O my God: unto thee will I sing with the harp, O thou Holy One of Israel.  
 Psalms 72:1 Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son.  
 Psalms 72:18 Blessed be the LORD God, the God of Israel, who only doeth wondrous things.  
 Psalms 73:1 Truly God is good to Israel, even to such as are of a clean heart.  
 Psalms 73:11 And they say, How doth God know? and is there knowledge in the most High?  
 Psalms 73:17 Until I went into the sanctuary of God; then understood I their end.  
 Psalms 73:26 My flesh and my heart faileth: but God is the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever.  
 Psalms 73:28 But it is good for me to draw near to God: I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, that I may declare all thy works.  
 Psalms 74:1 O God, why hast thou cast us off for ever? why doth thine anger smoke against the sheep of thy pasture?  
 Psalms 74:8 They said in their hearts, Let us destroy them together: they have burned up all the synagogues of God in the land.  
 Psalms 74:10 O God, how long shall the adversary reproach? shall the enemy blaspheme thy name for ever?  
 Psalms 74:12 For God is my King of old, working salvation in the midst of the earth.  
 Psalms 74:18 Remember this, that the enemy hath reproached, O LORD, and that the foolish people have blasphemed thy name.  
 Psalms 74:22 Arise, O God, plead thine own cause: remember how the foolish man reproacheth thee daily.  
 Psalms 75:1 Unto thee, O God, do we give thanks, unto thee do we give thanks: for that thy name is near thy wondrous works declare.  
 Psalms 75:7 But God is the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another.  
 Psalms 75:8 For in the hand of the LORD there is a cup, and the wine is red; it is full of mixture; and he poureth out of the same: but the dregs thereof, all  
 Psalms 75:9 But I will declare for ever; I will sing praises to the God of Jacob.  
 Psalms 76:1 In Judah is God known: his name is great in Israel.  
 Psalms 76:6 At thy rebuke, O God of Jacob, both the chariot and horse are cast into a dead sleep.  
 Psalms 76:9 When God arose to judgment, to save all the meek of the earth. Selah.  
 Psalms 76:11 Vow, and pay unto the LORD your God: let all that be round about him bring presents unto him that ought to be feared.  
 Psalms 77:1 I cried unto God with my voice, even unto God with my voice; and he gave ear unto me.  
 Psalms 77:3 I remembered God, and was troubled: I complained, and my spirit was overwhelmed. Selah.  
 Psalms 77:9 Hath God forgotten to be gracious? hath he in anger shut up his tender mercies? Selah.  
 Psalms 77:11 I will remember the works of the LORD: surely I will remember thy wonders of old.  
 Psalms 77:13 Thy way, O God, is in the sanctuary: who is so great a God as our God?  
 Psalms 77:14 Thou art the God that doest wonders: thou hast declared thy strength among the people.  
 Psalms 77:16 The waters saw thee, O God, the waters saw thee; they were afraid: the depths also were troubled.  
 Psalms 78:4 We will not hide them from their children, shewing to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and his strength, and his wonderful w  
 Psalms 78:7 That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:  
 Psalms 78:8 And might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation that set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not  
 Psalms 78:10 They kept not the covenant of God, and refused to walk in his law;  
 Psalms 78:18 And they tempted God in their heart by asking meat for their lust.  
 Psalms 78:19 Yea, they spake against God; they said, Can God furnish a table in the wilderness?  
 Psalms 78:21 Therefore the LORD heard this, and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel;  
 Psalms 78:22 Because they believed not in God, and trusted not in his salvation:  
 Psalms 78:31 The wrath of God came upon them, and slew the fattest of them, and smote down the chosen men of Israel.  
 Psalms 78:34 When he slew them, then they sought him: and they returned and enquired early after God.  
 Psalms 78:35 And they remembered that God was their rock, and the high God their redeemer.  
 Psalms 78:41 Yea, they turned back and tempted God, and limited the Holy One of Israel.  
 Psalms 78:56 Yet they tempted and provoked the most high God, and kept not his testimonies:  
 Psalms 78:59 When God heard this, he was wroth, and greatly abhorred Israel:  
 Psalms 79:1 O God, the heathen are come into thine inheritance; thy holy temple have they defiled; they have laid Jerusalem on heaps.  
 Psalms 79:5 How long, LORD? wilt thou be angry for ever? shall thy jealousy burn like fire?  
 Psalms 79:9 Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of thy name: and deliver us, and purge away our sins, for thy name's sake.  
 Psalms 79:10 Wherefore should the heathen say, Where is their God? let him be known among the heathen in our sight by the revenging of the blood of t  
 Psalms 80:3 Turn us again, O God, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.  
 Psalms 80:4 O LORD God of hosts, how long wilt thou be angry against the prayer of thy people?  
 Psalms 80:7 Turn us again, O God of hosts, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.  
 Psalms 80:14 Return, we beseech thee, O God of hosts: look down from heaven, and behold, and visit this vine;  
 Psalms 80:19 Turn us again, O LORD God of hosts, cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.  
 Psalms 81:1 Sing aloud unto God our strength: make a joyful noise unto the God of Jacob.  
 Psalms 81:4 For this was a statute for Israel, and a law of the God of Jacob.  
 Psalms 81:10 I am the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it.  
 Psalms 81:15 The haters of the LORD should have submitted themselves unto him: but their time should have endured for ever.  
 Psalms 82:1 God standeth in the congregation of the mighty; he judgeth among the gods.  
 Psalms 82:8 Arise, O God, judge the earth: for thou shalt inherit all nations.  
 Psalms 83:1 Keep not thou silence, O God: hold not thy peace, and be not still, O God.  
 Psalms 83:12 Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of God in possession.  
 Psalms 83:13 O my God, make them like a wheel; as the stubble before the wind.  
 Psalms 83:16 Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek thy name, O LORD.  
 Psalms 84:1 How amiable are thy tabernacles, O LORD of hosts!  
 Psalms 84:2 My soul longeth, yea, even fainteth for the courts of the LORD: my heart and my flesh crieth out for the living God.  
 Psalms 84:3 Yea, the sparrow hath found an house, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young, even thine altars, O LORD of host  
 Psalms 84:7 They go from strength to strength, every one of them in Zion appeareth before God.

Psalms 84:8 O LORD God of hosts, hear my prayer: give ear, O God of Jacob. Selah.  
 Psalms 84:9 Behold, O God our shield, and look upon the face of thine anointed.  
 Psalms 84:10 For a day in thy courts is better than a thousand. I had rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God, than to dwell in the tents of wickedne  
 Psalms 84:11 For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.  
 Psalms 84:12 O LORD of hosts, blessed is the man that trusteth in thee.  
 Psalms 85:1 LORD, thou hast been favourable unto thy land: thou hast brought back the captivity of Jacob.  
 Psalms 85:4 Turn us, O God of our salvation, and cause thine anger toward us to cease.  
 Psalms 85:7 Shew us thy mercy, O LORD, and grant us thy salvation.  
 Psalms 85:8 I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to folly.  
 Psalms 85:12 Yea, the LORD shall give that which is good; and our land shall yield her increase.  
 Psalms 86:1 Bow down thine ear, O LORD, hear me: for I am poor and needy.  
 Psalms 86:2 Preserve my soul; for I am holy: O thou my God, save thy servant that trusteth in thee.  
 Psalms 86:6 Give ear, O LORD, unto my prayer; and attend to the voice of my supplications.  
 Psalms 86:10 For thou art great, and doest wondrous things: thou art God alone.  
 Psalms 86:11 Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name.  
 Psalms 86:12 I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will glorify thy name for evermore.  
 Psalms 86:14 O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent men have sought after my soul; and have not set thee before them.  
 Psalms 86:15 But thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth.  
 Psalms 86:17 Shew me a token for good; that they which hate me may see it, and be ashamed: because thou, LORD, hast holpen me, and comforted me.  
 Psalms 87:2 The LORD loveth the gates of Zion more than all the dwellings of Jacob.  
 Psalms 87:3 Glorious things are spoken of thee, O city of God. Selah.  
 Psalms 87:6 The LORD shall count, when he writeth up the people, that this man was born there. Selah.  
 Psalms 88:1 O LORD God of my salvation, I have cried day and night before thee:  
 Psalms 88:9 Mine eye mourneth by reason of affliction: LORD, I have called daily upon thee, I have stretched out my hands unto thee.  
 Psalms 88:13 But unto thee have I cried, O LORD; and in the morning shall my prayer prevent thee.  
 Psalms 88:14 LORD, why castest thou off my soul? why hidest thou thy face from me?  
 Psalms 89:1 I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations.  
 Psalms 89:5 And the heavens shall praise thy wonders, O LORD: thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the saints.  
 Psalms 89:6 For who in the heaven can be compared unto the LORD? who among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto the LORD?  
 Psalms 89:7 God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all them that are about him.  
 Psalms 89:8 O LORD God of hosts, who is a strong LORD like unto thee? or to thy faithfulness round about thee?  
 Psalms 89:15 Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance.  
 Psalms 89:18 For the LORD is our defence; and the Holy One of Israel is our king.  
 Psalms 89:26 He shall cry unto me, Thou art my father, my God, and the rock of my salvation.  
 Psalms 89:46 How long, LORD? wilt thou hide thyself for ever? shall thy wrath burn like fire?  
 Psalms 89:51 Wherewith thine enemies have reproached, O LORD; wherewith they have reproached the footsteps of thine anointed.  
 Psalms 89:52 Blessed be the LORD for evermore. Amen, and Amen.  
 Psalms 90:2 Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art G  
 Psalms 90:13 Return, O LORD, how long? and let it repent thee concerning thy servants.  
 Psalms 90:17 And let the beauty of the LORD our God be upon us: and establish thou the work of our hands upon us; yea, the work of our hands establish  
 Psalms 91:2 I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.  
 Psalms 91:9 Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;  
 Psalms 92:1 It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:  
 Psalms 92:4 For thou, LORD, hast made me glad through thy work: I will triumph in the works of thy hands.  
 Psalms 92:5 O LORD, how great are thy works! and thy thoughts are very deep.  
 Psalms 92:8 But thou, LORD, art most high for evermore.  
 Psalms 92:9 For, lo, thine enemies, O LORD, for, lo, thine enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered.  
 Psalms 92:13 Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God.  
 Psalms 92:15 To shew that the LORD is upright: he is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him.  
 Psalms 93:1 The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, wherewith he hath girded himself: the world also is stabl  
 Psalms 93:3 The floods have lifted up, O LORD, the floods have lifted up their voice; the floods lift up their waves.  
 Psalms 93:4 The LORD on high is mightier than the noise of many waters, yea, than the mighty waves of the sea.  
 Psalms 93:5 Thy testimonies are very sure: holiness becometh thine house, O LORD, for ever.

 Psalms 94:14 For the LORD will not cast off his people, neither will he forsake his inheritance.  
 Psalms 94:17 Unless the LORD had been my help, my soul had almost dwelt in silence.  
 Psalms 94:18 When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up.  
 Psalms 94:22 But the LORD is my defence; and my God is the rock of my refuge.  
 Psalms 94:23 And he shall bring upon them their own iniquity, and shall cut them off in their own wickedness; yea, the LORD our God shall cut them off.  
 Psalms 95:1 O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation.  
 Psalms 95:3 For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.  
 Psalms 95:6 O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.  
 Psalms 95:7 For he is our God; and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. To day if ye will hear his voice,  
 Psalms 96:1 O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth.  
 Psalms 96:2 Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day.  
 Psalms 96:4 For the LORD is great, and greatly to be praised: he is to be feared above all gods.  
 Psalms 96:5 For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the LORD made the heavens.  
 Psalms 96:7 Give unto the LORD, O ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength.  
 Psalms 96:8 Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts.  
 Psalms 96:9 O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth.  
 Psalms 96:10 Say among the heathen that the LORD reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: he shall judge the people rig  
 Psalms 96:13 Before the LORD: for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth.  
 Psalms 97:1 The LORD reigneth; let the earth rejoice; let the multitude of isles be glad thereof.  
 Psalms 97:5 The hills melted like wax at the presence of the LORD, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.  
 Psalms 97:8 Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah rejoiced because of thy judgments, O LORD.  
 Psalms 97:9 For thou, LORD, art high above all the earth: thou art exalted far above all gods.  
 Psalms 97:10 Ye that love the LORD, hate evil: he preserveth the souls of his saints; he delivereth them out of the hand of the wicked.  
 Psalms 97:12 Rejoice in the LORD, ye righteous; and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness.  
 Psalms 98:1 O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory.

Psalms 98:2 The LORD hath made known his salvation: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen.  
 Psalms 98:3 He hath remembered his mercy and his truth toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.  
 Psalms 98:4 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise.  
 Psalms 98:5 Sing unto the LORD with the harp; with the harp, and the voice of a psalm.  
 Psalms 98:6 With trumpets and sound of cornet make a joyful noise before the LORD, the King.  
 Psalms 98:9 Before the LORD; for he cometh to judge the earth: with righteousness shall he judge the world, and the people with equity.  
 Psalms 99:1 The LORD reigneth; let the people tremble: he sitteth between the cherubims; let the earth be moved.  
 Psalms 99:2 The LORD is great in Zion; and he is high above all the people.  
 Psalms 99:5 Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his footstool; for he is holy.  
 Psalms 99:6 Moses and Aaron among his priests, and Samuel among them that call upon his name; they called upon the LORD, and he answered them.  
 Psalms 99:8 Thou answeredst them, O LORD our God: thou wast a God that forgavest them, though thou tookest vengeance of their inventions.  
 Psalms 99:9 Exalt the LORD our God, and worship at his holy hill; for the LORD our God is holy.  
 Psalms 100:1 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.  
 Psalms 100:2 Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing.  
 Psalms 100:3 Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.  
 Psalms 100:5 For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.  
 Psalms 101:1 I will sing of mercy and judgment: unto thee, O LORD, will I sing.  
 Psalms 101:8 I will early destroy all the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the LORD.  
 Psalms 102:1 Hear my prayer, O LORD, and let my cry come unto thee.  
 Psalms 102:12 But thou, O LORD, shalt endure for ever; and thy remembrance unto all generations.  
 Psalms 102:15 So the heathen shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth thy glory.

 Psalms 102:21 To declare the name of the LORD in Zion, and his praise in Jerusalem;  
 Psalms 102:22 When the people are gathered together, and the kingdoms, to serve the LORD.  
 Psalms 102:24 I said, O my God, take me not away in the midst of my days: thy years are throughout all generations.  
 Psalms 103:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.  
 Psalms 103:2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:  
 Psalms 103:6 The LORD executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed.  
 Psalms 103:8 The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy.  
 Psalms 103:13 Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear him.  
 Psalms 103:17 But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children' children;  
 Psalms 103:19 The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth over all.  
 Psalms 103:20 Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.  
 Psalms 103:21 Bless ye the LORD, all ye his hosts; ye ministers of his, that do his pleasure.  
 Psalms 103:22 Bless the LORD, all his works in all places of his dominion: bless the LORD, O my soul.  
 Psalms 104:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty.  
 Psalms 104:16 The trees of the LORD are full of sap; the cedars of Lebanon, which he hath planted;  
 Psalms 104:21 The young lions roar after their prey, and seek their meat from God.  
 Psalms 104:24 O LORD, how manifold are thy works! in wisdom hast thou made them all: the earth is full of thy riches.  
 Psalms 104:31 The glory of the LORD shall endure for ever: the LORD shall rejoice in his works.  
 Psalms 104:33 I will sing unto the LORD as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.  
 Psalms 104:34 My meditation of him shall be sweet: I will be glad in the LORD.  
 Psalms 104:35 Let the sinners be consumed out of the earth, and let the wicked be no more. Bless thou the LORD, O my soul. Praise ye the LORD.  
 Psalms 105:1 O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon his name: make known his deeds among the people.  
 Psalms 105:3 Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD.  
 Psalms 105:4 Seek the LORD, and his strength: seek his face evermore.  
 Psalms 105:7 He is the LORD our God: his judgments are in all the earth.  
 Psalms 105:19 Until the time that his word came: the word of the LORD tried him.  
 Psalms 105:45 That they might observe his statutes, and keep his laws. Praise ye the LORD.  
 Psalms 106:1 Praise ye the LORD. O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.  
 Psalms 106:2 Who can utter the mighty acts of the LORD? who can shew forth all his praise?

 Psalms 106:40 Therefore was the wrath of the LORD kindled against his people, insomuch that he abhorred his own inheritance.  
 Psalms 106:47 Save us, O LORD our God, and gather us from among the heathen, to give thanks unto thy holy name, and to triumph in thy praise.  
 Psalms 106:48 Blessed be the LORD God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting: and let all the people say, Amen. Praise ye the LORD.  
 Psalms 107:1 O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.  
 Psalms 107:2 Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;  
 Psalms 107:6 Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses.  
 Psalms 107:8 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!

 Psalms 107:24 These see the works of the LORD, and his wonders in the deep.  
 Psalms 107:28 Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses.

 Psalms 107:43 Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD.  
 Psalms 108:1 O God, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory.  
 Psalms 108:3 I will praise thee, O LORD, among the people: and I will sing praises unto thee among the nations.  
 Psalms 108:5 Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: and thy glory above all the earth;
